

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) **AMISFIELD LIMITED PARTNERSHIP** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **10 Arrowtown-Lake Hayes Road, Queenstown** and known as **AMISFIELD WINERY AND BISTRO** to any person for consumption off the premises, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

If this licence is *not* endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:
- b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made:
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated:
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8.00 am to 8.00 pm
- d) Freely available drinking water must be provided to all customers at all times alcohol is being provided free as a sample.
- e) The cellar door is designated **supervised** in accordance with the plan of the premises submitted to the District Licensing Committee on the 25 November 2013 and 20 July 2017.
- f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions of the supply of alcohol to minors and the prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons, identification of minors.
- g) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category:
Medium – Tavern Off-Licence.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) Either-
 - i) Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - i) Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
